A Dialogue on Europa Stamps by Ralph Wyndham

Europa stamps are a popular theme for collectors. The concept of the annual joint issue of Europathemed postage stamps was first brought to life in 1956 by the six member countries of the European Coal and Steel Community (France, Germany, Italy, Belgium, the Netherlands, and Luxembourg). A common design, the word EUROPA surrounded by construction scaffolding, was used to symbolize rebuilding.

025 REPUBLIQUE FRANÇAISE POSTS



In 1959, the European Conference of Postal and Telecommunications Administrations (acronym CEPT) was formed and the organization assumed management of the Europa issue. Starting with the CEPT's first stamp in 1960, the CEPT acronym and/or the Conference's logo -- four post horns and the letters CEPT -- appeared along with the word 'Europa' on the annual issue.

Wanting to focus more on telecommunications matters, the CEPT, in 1993, handed management of Europa-themed stamps to PostEurop, the European association of public postal operators.

PostEurop adopted the word 'Europa' in right-leaning letters as its logo and this was used on all issues. A stylized post box, also leaning to the right, was added to the logo in 2011.

In its earliest years, a common design was created for use by participating postal authorities but some still preferred to create their own designs. As a result, since 1974, only a theme is agreed upon and it is up to each participating country to decide how to present it. Common designs were used, however, in 2000, 2016, and, 2023. The 2023 common design "Peace, the highest value of humanity" was chosen at the suggestion of Ukraine after Russia's invasion. The original theme for 2023 was postponed to 2024.

Currently, there are around 60 countries taking part in the annual Europa issue. For 2024 'underwater flora and fauna' is the theme; 2025 will be 'national archaeological discoveries'.
